


## Features:

- Pitching and batting net
- Thick fiberglass poles
- Strong canvas trim
- Heavy gauge netting
- Collapsible heavy-duty steel frame
- 7'W x 7'H


## Parts:

- 1 Net
- 4 Steel Poles and Legs
- 4 Fiberglass Poles
- 4 Stakes
- 1 Carrying Bag



## Instructions:

1. Assemble the two straight steel poles. **Figure 1.**
2. Attach the steel pole to the legs. **Figure 2.**
3. Insert the two lower tubes into the angled pipes. **Figure 3.**
4. Slip one net sleeve over one of the lower fiberglass poles. Then insert it into either side base leg post. Repeat this step for opposite side with second lower fiberglass pole. **Figure 4.**
5. Insert upper fiberglass poles into lower fiberglass poles. **Figure 5.**
6. Hold poles while pulling sleeves up. Hook the white loop on the net around the notch. (Do not stand in direction of the pole while loading). **Figure 6.**
7. Insert the remaining poles down net sleeve and into frame. **Figure 7.**
8. Repeat Step 6 and 7 for opposite side with second white loop. **Figure 8.**
9. Attach the bottom Velcro® loops around the support pole and hook lower loops around the metal hooks. **Figure 9.**



## WARNING:

• Only use and set up with adult supervision • Do not drag, use two people to move net • Do not leave net set-up unattended overnight or for extended periods in inclement weather • Keep fingers away from hinges and joints • Only use a flat thumb to depress buttons • Net must only be used for the sport for which it was designed for • Replace damaged or missing parts IMMEDIATELY • Never climb or hang on net or framework • Always keep net securely anchored with stakes or sandbags • Unsecured net can fall over causing serious injury or death.
